In reply to Mayor Dorough, Mr. Davis explained the bankruptcy/reorganization of Purdue Pharma regarding opioid litigation, discussing the process which includes a disclosure statement and plan. Noting that there were 500 pages, he summarized that the plan establishes the abatement trust, which will be funded by Purdue, adding that the trust will be used by governmental bodies for incurred expenses, with a percentage of the funds distributed to each state's Attorney General for handling disbursement to local governmental bodies (percentages attached and on file).

In reply to Mayor Dorough, Mr. Davis commented on the other cities that are involved in this lawsuit, including those based outside of the USA.

Commissioner Fletcher moved to adopt the following resolution, seconded by Commissioner Howard, and following a roll call vote the motion unanimously carried.
