AN ORDINANCE 21-121 ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING THE REQUIREMENT OF MASKS OR FACE COVERINGS IN CITY OWNED BUILDINGS; REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2021, Governor Kemp issued Executive Order No. 05.28.21.02, which has lessened the requirement of masks or face coverings in public; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Albany, Georgia that the requirement of masks as well as face coverings in City owned buildings be rescinded,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia, and it is hereby resolved by authority of same:

SECTION 1. As of this date, neither masks nor face coverings are required in City owned buildings.

SECTION 2. All Resolutions, or parts of Resolutions, in conflict herewith are repealed.
