Article II of the Albany Dougherty Code of Ordinances regulates signs at Chapter 4, Section 4.75. For those zoning districts that permit the use of multi-message signage, the following restrictions apply:

- **Signs are limited to one per lot and must be a ground sign**
- **No part (message, copy, or image) will change more than once every 20 seconds**
- **Mechanically changed messages will be accomplished in 3 seconds or less**
- **Electronically changed messages (light source) will be changed instantaneously**
- **Sign will not depict motion through scrolling, flashing, etc.**
- **Size of multiple message sign face shall not exceed 50% of total sign face area**
- **Signs will remain static from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. if within 150 feet of residential district**
- **Light intensity must be pre-set at the factory**
- **Sign manufacturer's certification is required stating light does not exceed ordinance requirements and that intensity level is protected from end-user manipulation**
- **No sign shall exceed one-half footcandles on adjacent residential properties or two footcandles at any public right-of-way**
