AN ORDINANCE 21-130 ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF ALBANY'S FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR APPLICABLE PUBLIC SAFETY AND UTILITY OPERATIONS EMPLOYEES; REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, there are certain positions within the City's Public Safety and Utility Operations that have proven to be difficult to recruit and retain; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to adjust salaries to make more robust the City's recruitment and retention process; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Albany to adopt such amendment so that the City's Human Resources Department can implement salary adjustments as follows: \$178,266 to the Albany Police Department, \$228,521 to the Albany Fire Department, and \$59,879 to Utilities Operation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Board of Commissioners hereby approve this budget amendment for the fiscal year 2022 Adopted Budget by amending same to show an increase in the amount of \$466,666.

SECTION 2. The Finance Director is authorized and directed to make appropriate lineitem adjustments to the budget for FY 22.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are repealed.
