AN ORDINANCE 21-131 ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF ALBANY'S FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET SO AS TO ASSIST THE CIVIL RIGHTS INSTITUTE IN PROCURING A MASTER PLAN; REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, during the recent Commission Retreat, there was consensus to seek assistance with a master plan for the Civil Rights Institute; and

WHEREAS, \$35,000 of Hotel/Motel Tax is allocated to the Civil Rights Institute provided there is a Memorandum of Understanding between Civil Rights Institute and the Convention and Visitors Bureau that is consistent with the purposes of the Hotel/Motel Tax; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Albany to adopt a budget amendment to assist the Civil Rights Institute with a master plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Board of Commissioners hereby approve this budget amendment for the fiscal year 2022 Adopted Budget by amending same to show an increase in the amount of \$35,000.00.

SECTION 2. The Finance Director is authorized and directed to make appropriate lineitem adjustments to the budget for FY 22.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are repealed.
