

AN ORDINANCE **22-103**
ENTITLED

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 2-47(r)
PROVIDING FOR EXPENSE ACCOUNTS FOR MAYOR AND
COMMISSIONERS; REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES
AND CHARTER PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, at the June 21, 2022 Work Session, City Manager Steven Carter led discussion of adjusting the FY23 budget; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Albany to make adjustments to the budget for FY 23 providing for expense accounts for the Mayor and Board of Commissioners,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same:

SECTION 1. Section 2-47(r) of the City Code shall hereafter read as follows:


Sec. 2-47. Expense accounts for mayor and commissioners.

(r) Nothing contained within subsections (b) through (n) of this section shall be interpreted as authorization to exceed the expense account limitation of **\$15,000.00** per annum for the mayor and **\$10,000.00** per annum for each commissioner or one-half of the annual allocation if the elected official was not serving prior to the organizational meeting.

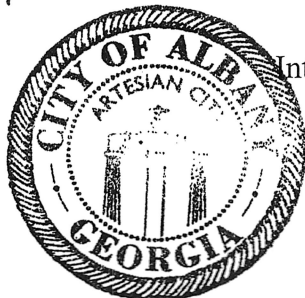
SECTION 2. All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith are repealed.
