AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 2-47(C)(2) SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ATTENDANCE AT CONFERENCES OF MEAG, MGAG AND ECG; REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, this proposed ordinance will amend Sec. 2-47 of the City Code to provide for additional conference attendance; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Albany to adopt this ordinance,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same:

SECTION 1. Sec. 2-47(c)(2) of the City Code as it presently exists, to-wit:

(c) The city clerk or assistant city clerk shall provide travel assistance to the mayor and commissioners upon representation by that official that the meeting, seminar, or convocation she desires to attend is reasonably related to city business. This includes registration, reservations for transportation and lodging, and other assistance that may be applicable.

(2) Attendance at all Georgia Municipal Association, Georgia Association of Black Elected Officials and National League of Cities meetings, including those committees to which the elected official may belong, and meetings of the board of directors, where they are members, shall be deemed to be reasonably related to city business.

SECTION 2. Sec. 2-47(c)(2) is hereby amended and in its place shall hereafter read:

(c) The city clerk or assistant city clerk shall provide travel assistance to the mayor and commissioners upon representation by that official that the meeting, seminar, or convocation she desires to attend is reasonably related to city business. This includes registration, reservations for transportation and lodging, and other assistance that may be applicable.

(2) Attendance at all Georgia Municipal Association, Georgia Association of Black Elected Officials, National League of Cities meetings, **Municipal Electric Authority of Georgia, Municipal Gas Authority of Georgia and Electric Cities of Georgia,**

including those committees to which the elected official may belong, and meetings of the board of directors, where they are members, shall be deemed to be reasonably related to city business.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith are repealed.
