

AN ORDINANCE 22-117  
ENTITLED  
**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE COMPENSATION PAID TO  
ALBANY UTILITY BOARD MEMBERS; REPEALING PRIOR  
ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1972-1707 adopted on September 11, 1972, fixed the salary of members of the Board of Water, Gas and Light Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia, now known as Albany Utility Board, to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month; and


WHEREAS, in 2007 the compensation was increased to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month, and the instant Ordinance memorializes same,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same:

SECTION 1. This Commission does hereby increase the compensation of the members of the Albany Utility Board to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month.

SECTION 2. This increase shall become effective immediately upon adoption of this Ordinance.

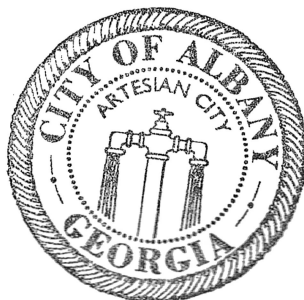
SECTION 3. All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith are repealed.
