AN ORDINANCE 22-118

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 36, CHAPTER 35 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA ANNOTATED, AS AMENDED, AMENDING SECTION 3(e) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY SO AS TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS; REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES AND CHARTER PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Albany to increase the salaries of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same:

SECTION 1. Section 3(e) of the Charter of the City of Albany, as amended, is hereby deleted.

SECTION 2. Section 3(e) of the Charter of the City of Albany shall hereafter read as follows:

(e) Salaries. Each member of the board of commissioners of the City of Albany, except the mayor, shall receive a salary of twenty-two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$22,800) per annum, payable in monthly installments on the first day of each month. The mayor of the City of Albany shall receive a salary of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) per annum, payable in monthly installments on the first day of each month.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to the provisions of §36-35-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, this Ordinance shall become effectively immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia at two regularly scheduled consecutive meetings and after compliance with all of the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Act of 1965, as amended.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, and all Charter provisions, or parts of Charter provisions, in conflict herewith are repealed.
