Mr. Davis discussed information (copy on file) and advised that the change has to do with the State of Georgia’s share of the settlement which will pass through the House of Representatives and go to the General Assembly.

In reply to Commissioner Howard, Mr. Davis explained that eventually the City will receive its share, adding that two checks (\$90,000) have already been received. Regarding non-profits being able to receive funding, he advised that there are stipulations entities must adhere to before disbursing any funds.

Mayor Dorough asked for a list of those the City has received payment from, proposals from staff on spending the funds, and a memo of what the State has received.
