

City of Albany dba Albany Utility Board Acceptable Use Policy

Introduction

This Acceptable Use Policy (hereinafter referred to as "AUP") outlines acceptable and prohibited activities for users of City of Albany dba Albany Utility Board (hereinafter referred to as "City of Albany") Internet services. By using our services, users agree to comply with this AUP and all applicable laws and regulations.

Compliance with Laws and Regulations

Users must comply with all local, state, and federal laws, including but not limited to:

- FCC Regulations: Adherence to FCC regulations regarding net neutrality, privacy, and other relevant standards.
- Copyright Laws: Respect for intellectual property rights and avoidance of copyright infringement. Other Relevant Laws:
- Compliance with laws related to child exploitation, harassment, fraud, and other criminal activities.

Prohibited Activities

Users may not use City of Albany's services to engage in any of the following prohibited activities:

- Illegal Activities: Conducting or promoting illegal activities.
- Security Violations: Engaging in activities that compromise network security, such as hacking, distributing viruses, or unauthorized access to systems.
- Spam and Unsolicited Communications: Sending unsolicited bulk messages (spam) or engaging in email or message spoofing.

- Reporting Violations: Promptly reporting any violations of this AUP or security breaches to City of Albany.

Violations of this AUP may result in:

- Warning Notices: Initial warnings for minor violations.
- Service Suspension: Temporary suspension of services for repeated or severe violations.
- Termination of Service: Permanent termination of services for serious or ongoing violations.
- Legal Action: Referral to law enforcement or pursuit of legal remedies as appropriate.
