

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for Public Works Solid Waste Division

**Question:** What time and where should the wheeled garbage barrel be placed for collection?

**Answer:** The barrel should be placed at the curb adjacent to your property or in the alley behind your house no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day before your collection day or no later than 7:00 a.m. on the designated pick up day.

**Question:** How to prevent billing/charges to your account when you vacate the property and leave utilities connected?

**Answer:** Residential customers are required by city ordinance to have solid waste services when the residence is occupied. In order for services to be terminated and the billing discontinued, it is the customer's responsibility to promptly provide written notice to Public Works – Solid Waste Division requesting the service be terminated. Otherwise, charges will continue until the department has been properly notified. Please do not expect any credit on your bill when you fail to provide prompt written notice.

**Question:** How often is yard debris collected?

**Answer:** According to the Solid Waste Ordinance, yard debris shall be collected twice

per month.

**Question:** Should yard trimmings be separated from other debris?

**Answer:** According to the Solid Waste Ordinance, yard trimmings shall not be mixed with any other debris, and it shall be the owner/occupant/tenant's responsibility to separate all debris and place in separate piles for collection.

**Question:** What is the monthly rate for residential household garbage collection?

**Answer:** Effective January 1, 2018 the rate is \$32.12.



**Question:** What is the monthly rate for commercial garbage collection?

**Answer:** Due to the variation of services that may be rendered such as number of collection days per week, size of dumpster, etc., please call 229-435-4166 or 311 in order for us to schedule a time to discuss the best option for you.
