## A RESOLUTION ENTITLED

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 15-R105 <u>RE</u> TRAFFIC CALMING POLICY; REPEALING PRIOR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City previously adopted a Traffic Calming Policy ("Policy") set forth in Resolution 09-R214, modified by Resolution 15-R105; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners have decided to amend 15-R105 and identify standards governing where traffic calming devices should be deployed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Albany, Georgia and it is hereby resolved by authority of same:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Resolution 15-R105 is deleted.

SECTION 2. Hereafter, these additional standards will be used in evaluating installation of traffic calming measures and are incorporated into Section 2.4 of the City's Traffic Calming Policy:

City staff will draft a preliminary traffic calming measure design to be provided with each petition packet.

Where the property owner fails to reply to a petition within 30 days, residents of the street may sign the petition, residency to be verified through utility billing system.

The signature of the senior executive of a Government owned properties will be accepted.

Large lots, such as schools, shall be pro-rated to match the corresponding number of lots in the defined service area.

The City Commission may override and require traffic calming measures at locations deemed necessary due to public safety concerns.

The City Commission may approve a Collector street for installation of traffic calming measures.

SECTION 3. All Resolutions, or parts of Resolutions, in conflict herewith are repealed.
