Mentioning a 1970 Supreme Court rule, he stated that the protocols the City has put in place violates the rule (i.e., requiring City Manager to have prior experience). He advised that if the US Attorney for the Middle District does not respond to this, they will take it to the Attorney General and further to the Senate/House if no action is taken by the Attorney General.
